



	<p><u>WISE Update: (Update April 30, 2021)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An amendment approved on April 16, 2021, includes Catrina Sallesse, who will work with Jide Oni and Rezwanul Hoque in data collection. • After last year's baseline survey (n- 169), the first follow-up survey (n- 78) and second follow-up survey (n-31) were done with the same respondents (at-risk FN youths) to see about food, housing, assets and other shifts under COVID-19 and due to training. • We are wrapping up with second wave (COVID 19) survey and preparing for the third wave survey. • Compare the second wave survey results with the first wave, where we found 100% food insecurity in Island Lake. • We are also preparing to have new participants when the KITIGAY program starts. <p><u>Indigenous Philanthropy (Update April 30, 2021)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working with two communities- Brokenhead Ojibway Nation and Dakaota Wahpeton Oyate.
